A large church saves time by serving communion elements in two cups. The bottom cup holds one piece of communion bread and the top cup holds the juice. The cups are stable when served in communion trays and the top cup does not crush the bread.

Not only does this save time during service, it also requires fewer people to serve communion. It's also a hygienic way to serve the bread since many hands are not taking communion wafers from a common plate.
