Scope & Sequence

Year 1		
Quarter	Title	Description
Quarter 1: Fall	Genesis: Creation through Isaac	Introduces the fascinating record of God's Creation and the beginning of the human race. Also learn about key biblical figures and the choices they made.
Quarter 2: Winter	David: A Man after God's Own Heart	Recounts the life of David, from shepherd to king, including his victories, struggles, and royal lineage. David's life reveals the importance of trusting God to solve problems.
Quarter 3: Spring	Jacob & Joseph	Explores the lives of a deceiver and a dreamer, while focusing on the sovereign God who guided each man's steps.
Quarter 4: Summer	Joshua & Judges	Reveals an exciting time in Israel's history as the Hebrew people learned the importance of obeying God and not yielding to the world.

Year 2		
Quarter	Title	Description
Quarter 1: Fall	Miracles! Mighty Works of God	Describes God's supernatural provision for His children throughout Scripture. Favorite Bible stories, including Jesus' later ministry, show God's care.
Quarter 2: Winter	Christmas, Ruth, & Daniel	Recounts the wonderful events surrounding the Savior's birth. The life of Ruth demonstrates faithfulness, while Daniel shows strength and courage in adversity.

Quarter 3: Spring	Easter, Esther, & Parables	Presents the events surrounding Christ's death, burial, and resurrection. Esther exhibited courage as God used her to deliver His people. Jesus' wonderful parables teach biblical truths.
Quarter 4: Summer	Christ's Ministry	Begins with Jesus' baptism and temptation, then focuses on His many miracles, including physical healing, power over nature, and forgiveness of sin.

Year 3

Quarter	Title	Description
Quarter 1: Fall	Ezra, Nehemiah, & Parables	Illustrates how God used two men to rally His people and lead them in the rebuilding of the Temple and Jerusalem's city walls. This study encourages listeners to build up their own spiritual walls of protection against the devil and with God's help be victorious. Continues with parables about pride, forgiveness, foolishness, wisdom, the importance of prayer, and other biblical principles.
Quarter 2: Winter	Moses & Christmas	Highlights God's power and provision in the life of His people as they exit Egypt and journey to the Promised Land. It also emphasizes the importance of God's commands and the consequences suffered for disobedience. The Christmas story recounts the events and purpose of the birth of the Savior.
Quarter 3: Spring	Acts & Easter	Highlights the events of Christ's atoning death, burial, and resurrection. The study then progresses to instruction in spiritual growth, then follows the events of Acts, from Pentecost and Stephen's martyrdom, to Paul's ministry, missionary journeys and death in Rome.
Quarter 4: Summer	Teachings of Jesus	Explores the life lessons Christ taught us throughout His earthly ministry, from the Beatitudes and parables to His miraculous power over all creation.

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
