# **Preparing to Teach**

The Lord is a perfect example of the "Good Shepherd." Psalm 23 is written for each of us. Take time this week to read over this Psalm several times, meditating on our wonderful "shepherd" who cares for us and meets our needs.

Scripture to read

Matthew 18:12-14 Luke 15:4-6

**■** Goal for lesson

The children will learn that God loves us even when we sin.

**■** Class memory verse

"I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." —John 14:6

**Note:** Be sure to read pp. 6–9 for teaching songs, memory verses, Bible lessons, and other elements of the class time.

# Sunday at a Glance



We arrive 10 min —

Greet children, collect offering, and have children put sticker on attendance chart. Show them where to sit, and have them color their Take-Home paper. Collect papers to hand out at dismissal time.

### **Teaching Tips**

Visit with the children during this time. Find out new things about them as you help them get settled and busy coloring.

We begin 1 min

Welcome children; recognize birthdays and visitors.

We sing 3-4 min

"He Is Lord" p. 62 track #8
"B-I-B-L-E" p. 5 (sing 2x, last time standing) track #2

Bring a bucket of water and a small doll that a child can dunk into the water 7 times as you review the lesson.

**We review God's Word** *Naaman and the Servant Girl* (*Part 2*) 4–5 min

We learn God's Word Memory Verse; 3–4 min —

John 14:6 "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." John 14:6

**We pray** 3–4 min Two children \_\_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_ and teacher pray.

We learn Bible truth questions 12–16 (new). 2 min —

We sing 2-3 min -

"Christ Arose" p. 58 vv. 1–2 track #3 "Lord Is My Shepherd" p. 29 track #12

Review verses previously learned. *Optional:* Have Bible Memory Picture Cards for John 14:6 ready to hand out at end of class.

Praise those who are learning the Bible Truth questions and answers. It will encourage others to learn them as well.

Children love to sing "Christ Arose," even long after Easter has come and gone, and it is a good reminder of what Christ has done for them.

Bring a stuffed animal lamb today to use while you teach the Bible lesson. You might want to allow several children to take turns holding the lamb during the story time. As you close the lesson, thank God that He loves and cares for us and calls us His little lambs.

We listen to God's Word Bible Lesson; 10–12 min

**Lost Lamb** End lesson with prayer.

#### We talk about the story 1–2 min

- 1. Who took care of the sheep and kept them from danger? the shepherd
- 2. What happened to the little lamb that did not obey the shepherd? *He got lost and was hurt.*

We sing 1–2 min

"B-I-B-L-E" p. 5 track #2

We make a craft 8–10 min

Activity Book pp. 27, 29

**Dismissal** As you distribute the Take-Home papers, sing together again "The Lord Is My Shepherd."

Do the craft step by step with the children, helping those who may be struggling with a part of the project.
