#### **Preparing to Teach**

When calling on children to pray publicly be sure to help each child as needed. The goal is for **each child to pray independently.** If a child is reluctant to pray after you've encouraged him, then wait a couple of weeks and again assist him in the same manner. Do not force a child who is timid, shy, or fearful, but pleasantly encourage him.
