Preparing to Teach

David's friendship with Jonathan made a tremendous impact on David's life. He kept his promise to Jonathan, showing kindness to his children.

David's son Solomon wrote about a faithful friend in the book of Proverbs. "Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend."—Prov. 27:17

Children need to know what to look for in a friend. Use this lesson to teach the boys and girls the importance of choosing good friends.
