God gave you two hands and two feet. Where are they? Can you march with your feet? Can you clap with your hands? We use our hands and feet when we play with our pets and our friends. What fun we can have with our hands and feet! We can also use our hands and feet to do kind things for our friends. (cont.)

(Show Card 24.) God gave you eyes, ears, and a mouth. Where are your eyes? Your eyes help you see and learn about everything God has made. *(Let the children look at themselves in a mirror, if available, and point out their special features.)* Where are your ears? Your ears help you hear people talking, birds singing, dogs barking, and cars or buses driving by. They hear me telling you stories about God. Where is your mouth? God gave you your mouth so that you can taste and eat the good things He made for you.

Thank you, God, for making me, me.
